

EXHIBITOR CERTIFICATES OF INSURANCE (COIs)

TRANSLATION AVAILABLE IN: ITALIAN MANDARIN CHINESE PORTUGUESE SPANISH TURKISH

All Exhibitors, including those within designated pavilions, are REQUIRED provide proof of liability insurance in the form of a Certificate of Insurance (COI) by February 16, 2026.

- Exhibitors are required to carry general liability coverage from an insurance company in good standing with minimum policy limits of \$1,000,000 per occurrence and \$2,000,000 aggregate.
- Insurance must be in force during the lease dates of the event, March 21-April 8, 2026

Note: No exhibitor personnel will be allowed into the exhibit hall to set-up until a valid Certificate of Insurance is on file with <u>Sales@rainprotection.net</u>.

If you do not have insurance, or you would rather not use your own insurance, (similar to when you rent a car – so that claims would not be filed against your policy), we have set up a program with <u>Rainprotection</u>
<u>Insurance</u> through which you can <u>purchase compliant insurance instantly online for \$109</u>.

General Liability Insurance:

- Protects exhibitors who do not have Commercial General Liability Insurance or who do not want to use their own insurance.
- Protects foreign exhibitors whose insurance will not pay claims brought in U.S. courts.

If you are part of a Pavilion, please work with your Pavilion Organizer to confirm whether they will be purchasing insurance for the entire Pavilion or if exhibitors are responsible for acquiring their own insurance.
