CONTACTED BY A FRAUDULENT COMPANY? HERE'S WHAT YOU CAN DO

PWX exhibitors are frequently targeted by companies unaffiliated with APWA or PWX, offering a variety of services such as attendee lists, housing, show decorating needs, and more. Please use caution when dealing with solicitations from companies that are not using the official PWX vendor logo (shown above) or are not on the above list of official PWX vendors.

If you think you've been contacted by a fraudulent company, you can now take action thanks to a recent rule issued by the Federal Trade Commission (FTC): [The Government and Business Impersonation Rule](#).

Please report fraud cases by following these steps:

- Go to reportfraud.ftc.gov.
- Click the "Report Now" button in the hero image.
- Select the "An impersonator" option (it's on the top left of the ten boxes).
- Then select "Well-known or trusted business" (top box on the right column).
- Complete process from there, which should only take 1-2 minutes.
